- Always copy the problem, show all work, and box your answer.
- NO WORK = NO CREDIT! NO EXCEPTIONS!

Make-up Work:

- All make-up work is your responsibility. An assignment calendar will be given to you for reference.
- Notes from when you are absent must be printed from the website and filled-in before you come back to class. Missing classwork should also be printed from the website and attempted before returning to class. Missed quizzes will not be made up but replaced with the unit test grade. Utilize tutoring times for questions.
